- Timpani:** Playing a rhythmic accompaniment with a forte (*f*) dynamic, using a wood mallet.
- Percussion 1:** Playing a rhythmic accompaniment with a forte (*f*) dynamic, using an ord. Mallet and Tambourine.
- Percussion 2:** Playing a rhythmic accompaniment with a forte (*f*) dynamic, using a Snare drum.
- Percussion 3 & 4:** Resting.
- Mallets 1:** Playing a rhythmic accompaniment with a forte (*f*) dynamic, using *xilo.* (xylophone).
- Mallets 2:** Playing a rhythmic accompaniment with a forte (*f*) dynamic, using *Mari.* (maracas).
